Covid-19 provisions on how to travel and enter in Italy

✓ Check which are your obligations according to the Italian law concerning Covid-19 Obligations are different according to where do you come from (home or transit country) - Ministry of Health website

✓ Abide to the rules and obligations for your country of origin (such as self —isolation period, compulsory swab test etc)



The Italian zone -system

Italy is currently divided in different zones under a national colour-coded system of YELLOW, ORANGE and RED that indicates coronavirus risk and the restrictions in place.

Depending on the colour of each zone:

- ✓ people are allowed to more freely or only under certain conditions
- ✓ shops and restaurant are open or closed
- ✓ night-time curfew is in place



The Italian zone -system

YELLOW ZONE

- Traveling between regions is prohibited
- Museums are open only on weekdays. Gyms, swimming pools, cinemas, theaters and ski lifts stay closed.
- Restaurants and bars close at 6pm. No takeaway from bars after this time
- A maximum of 2 people can go to another person's house, only once a day







- Moving outside the municipality is prohibited
- Shops, hairdressers and beauty centers are open. Bars and restaurants remain closed
- Transfers from municipalities up to 5000 inhabitants are allowed not exceeding 30km, but never to provincial capitals







- It is forbidden to leave the house except to go to work or to go shopping
- Supermarkets, pharmacies, newsagents and tobacconists are open
- You can go to another person's home only once a day and a maximum of two extra-cohabiting people







The Italian zone -system

Lombardy is currently in yellow zone but each region status is subject to verification on a weekly basis.

- 1. DO NOT access University premises if in the last 15 days:
- Your body temperature is or has been ≥ 37.5 °C;
- ✓ You had contacts with COVID-19 positive people;
- ✓ You have or had a combination of at least three of the following symptoms:

sore throat; cough and / or difficulty breathing; nasal obstruction; tiredness / muscle aches; diarrhea and /or vomiting; alteration of tastes and smells


2. Face covering is compulsory: when you are in the university common areas (classrooms, laboratories, common areas etc.) always wear a face mask (FFP2 or surgical mask) to protect nose and mouth

3. In classrooms, only **sit in the allowed sits** (they will be highlighted by special signals), avoid gatherings and physical contact

Hygiene of environments and surfaces

- ✓ Increased cleaning of classrooms and campus common spaces: daily cleaning and sanitization of the common areas, classrooms and surfaces of most contact.
- ✓ Each classroom / laboratory is equipped with a kit containing the disinfectant gel and sanitizing products for surfaces, multimedia equipments (PC, keyboards and microphones) or laboratory equipments.
- ✓ Safe ventilation: classroom windows will be opened for 15 minutes every two hours.



Alternating online and in-person class sessions


- ✓ all Courses held on campus will be also delivered online
