CALL FOR ERASMUS+ OUTGOING SHORT STUDENT MOBILITIES BLENDED INTENSIVE PROGRAMME CLAUSURA 23 academic year 2022/23

In the framework of the Erasmus+ Programme – KA131 Learning Mobility of Individuals, and on the basis of the results and the funds awarded under the project Erasmus 2021-1-IT02-KA131-HED-000007907, a call for students' selection is published to assign contributions to take part into the **BLENDED INTENSIVE PROGRAMME named** *CLAUSURA23* hereafter referred to as "**BIP**".

The aim of the BIP is to develop a multidisciplinary project for the revitalization of the Altenberg Monastery near Wetzlar (Germany). Several architectural expertise is required to understand and design the best spatial and functional organization and reuse of the existing building. Using of software for architectural representation and capabilities to interact with other engineers and architects are required.

1. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Applicants must fulfil the following compulsory criteria:

- To be duly enrolled at the University of Pavia for the entire duration of the Mobility;
- To have passed the "Architettura Tecnica 1" exam with at least 28/30;
- To speak technical English. Students will be required to communicate and discuss fluently about architecture and design process and take part in group activities.

2. DETAILS ABOUT THE MOBILITY

The BIP *Clausura23* will take place online on July 14th and 18th and in presence at **University of Gießen**, Germany, **from September 4th to 15th, 2023** (both included). The course will be considered completed and funded only if the participants will attend the full programme of the entire online part and of the **12 training days in presence**.

University of Gießen will provide the students with a certificate of attendance including the total number of hours attended together with the topics treated and the number of ECTS obtained.

3. MOBILITY GRANTS

• The mobility grant includes subsistence for a maximum of 14 days; 12 (twelve) full days of training + 2 (two) days of travelling, immediately before and after the beginning and finishing date of the course;

- The subsistence sum is 70,00 \in per day per student (980,00 \in), aiming at covering travel, accommodation and meals costs.
- Mobility grants will be paid by the University of Pavia, **before the beginning of the mobility in** • **presence**, provided that the participant has attended the Blended Intensive programme school for its entire duration and they are able to provide travel documents (e.g. boarding passes). The grant must be refunded in case the student will not be able to join the mobility its entire duration (physical + virtual);
- The mobility grant is a fixed amount of money that cannot be incremented under any • circumstances:
- The University of Pavia will provide its outgoing students with insurance covering accidents, • civil liability and other guarantees in accordance with its internal procedures.

4. ONLINE APPLICATION AND DEADLINE

The applicant is required to complete the online application form at the following link by the 26/04/2023 at 12:00 CET - noon.

5. EVALUATION AND SELECTION

The selection will be made by a joint Committee established within the Department of Civil Engineering and Architecture headed by prof. Alessandro Greco.

The following criteria will be taken into consideration:

- The attitude to design in group and to develop architectural projects in team;
- A clear idea of how the applicant expects to implement and follow up with the knowledge acquired in the BIP – how would their participation benefit their future goals;
- Motivation shown. •

In case of equal evaluation between two candidates, the Evaluation Commission reserves the right to give priority to those applications which add to the diversity of the study programme in terms of gender balance, year of study, and variety of mobility experience.

The Committee reserves the right to check the validity of declarations and supporting documents. False statements may lead to exclusion from the selection process and the award of the scholarship.

Each applicant will be notified about selection results and the grant in due time, via the email address provided in the application.

Selected applicants must then officially accept the awarded grant by answering via email.
