**ADDITIONAL SELECTION REQUIREMENTS AND CRITERIA
ESTABLISHED WITHIN INDIVIDUAL ERASMUS AREA**

BIOLOGY AND BIOTECHNOLOGY

It is recommended that interested students attend the Area Info Day organized to provide information about the call and advice on how to submit applications. Additionally, they should consult the Erasmus pages on the University website for information on the Erasmus mobility program.

Candidates will be selected solely based on the online application, which will be evaluated for completeness, particularly regarding motivations and details of the chosen academic activities at the three preferred host Universities.

It is advised to apply only after verifying that the chosen destinations are suitable for activities compatible with the individual curriculum of studies. This includes equivalence in offered courses to those of the UNIPV study plan, the possibility of conducting practical labs and thesis activities, and the required level of language proficiency.

Please note that to carry out the thesis activity during mobility, candidates - once selected - must identify a professor from their degree program or the University willing to supervise the thesis presentation, and a laboratory that will host them at the chosen Erasmus destination. Upon return, they must submit a certificate or letter issued by the foreign professor/institution attesting to the laboratory/research activities conducted.

CHEMISTRY

Students willing to attend a laboratory course abroad, upon return, must submit a certificate (or a letter issued by the professor) attesting to their attendance in the laboratory.

COMMUNICATION

MOBILITY INCENTIVES: The completed Erasmus experience entitles the recognition of 6 ECTS in place of internship activities.

No specific requirements.

LAW

No selection interview is planned.

ENGINEERING

No specific requirements.

MATHEMATICS

Students enrolled in the Mathematics degree programs (bachelor's and master's) can refer to Professor Ada Pulvirenti (ada.pulvirenti@unipv.it).

MEDICINE AND SURGERY

Eligible to apply are:

- Students regularly enrolled for the academic year 2023/24:
 - In the I, II, III, IV, and V years of the Single-Cycle Master's Degree Program in Medicine and Surgery (LM41 Golgi and Harvey Course)
 - In the I and II years of the bachelor's degree Programs in Nursing, Dietetics, Motor Sciences, Physiotherapy, Neuro and Psychomotor Development, Occupational Therapy, Biomedical Laboratory Techniques
 - In the I, II, III, IV, and V years of the Single-Cycle Master's Degree Program in Dentistry and Dental Prosthetics
 - In the I year of the master's degree program in Sports Sciences and Techniques and Preventive and Adaptive Motor Activities
- Those enrolled for the academic year 2023/24 in Specialization Schools and PhD programs affiliated with the faculty.
- Students enrolled in the Medicine and Surgery degree program must have passed the propaedeutic exams specified in the course programming for the year of application.
- For students enrolled in the VI year in 2023/24, and for all those who are repeating or out of course, the Commission reserves the right to evaluate individual requests and related issues.

NOTES

- The Erasmus Area Commission of Medicine is composed of the Delegate for International Mobility of the Erasmus Area, acting as the President, professors from the Medicine and Surgery Golgi and Harvey degree program, and a representative for each of the other degree programs affiliated with the Commission
- In the development of the educational program to be carried out abroad, it is necessary to respect the prerequisite exams established in the Italian system and verify the "core" of the program of the chosen subject, which must be in line with the Italian program. In particular:
 1. As a rule, it will not be possible to advance exams from subsequent years, except for a careful evaluation of each case, considering the regularity, rationality, and completeness of the presented program, considering credit covalence and educational value
 2. It is preferable to include integrated courses in the learning agreement rather than course modules. However, given the diversity of the educational offerings of various partner Universities, study plans will be carefully evaluated on a case-by-case basis. If the need arises to include only modules of an integrated course, it will be possible to complete the remaining parts of the course once back at the University
 3. Study plans that foresee the recovery of debts from previous years inappropriately and incongruously, not inserted in a project of curricular organicity, will not be accepted
- Considering the above indications, regarding students of the Medicine degree program: it is not recommended to apply for the Erasmus experience before the III year and for the VI year (finding compatible study plans at the affiliated Universities is very challenging), which should primarily be reserved for thesis elaboration.

MUSICOLOGY AND CULTURAL HERITAGE

No selection interview is planned.

MOBILITY INCENTIVES: Upon obtaining the degree, students who have participated in an Erasmus+ program or training activities during study periods at foreign universities for the bachelor's degree in Literary Studies and Cultural Heritage and the bachelor's and master's Degree Programs in Musicology will be awarded an additional score of 1 point.

PSYCHOLOGY

Interested students are invited to participate in the Info Day and consult the UNIPV Psychology - Erasmus section website for specific and up-to-date information. A selection interview is planned, focusing on the evaluation of candidates' motivation.

DRUGS SCIENCE

It is necessary for those intending to apply to contact the exchange coordinator before applying to be directed correctly. To carry out the thesis abroad, it is necessary to have obtained 150 ECTS credits by the deadline of the call.

EARTH AND ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCES

No specific requirements.

BUSINESS AND ECONOMICS

DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED

The selection committee does not conduct interviews.

CHANGE OF UNIVERSITY AND ALLOCATION OF VACANT DESTINATIONS

The student cannot request a change of the assigned University.

If a student applies for destinations whose places have already been assigned to students ranking higher, they can compete for the allocation of remaining vacancies compatible with the language tests passed and their level and field of study. The date of the reallocation meeting will be communicated simultaneously with the publication of the results of this Erasmus selection.

ERASMUS/DOUBLE DEGREE ALLOCATION

Students already assigned of Double Degree will be assigned to the same University regardless of the priority order indicated in the Erasmus application, always respecting the ranking order.

Furthermore, by accepting a Double Degree spot, the student automatically renounces the opportunity to compete in the Erasmus ranking for destinations different from the one assigned for the Double Degree.

For Universities with both an Erasmus agreement and a Double Degree agreement, students assigned a Double Degree spot will be given a priority bonus.

THESIS RESEARCH ABROAD

Students interested in conducting thesis research during the Erasmus mobility period must verify, before applying, the availability of the foreign institution to accept Erasmus students for this activity. To do so, students must directly contact the Erasmus coordinator of the foreign University.

POLITICAL AND SOCIAL SCIENCES
