PROGRAM AND COIMBRA GROUP SEN MEMBER UNIVERSITIES**

ACADEMIC YEAR 2024/25

Following the selection process for the call Erasmus for Study 2024/25, the remaining vacant destinations and additional new ones are now available.

Interested students can apply for this second call, for which the same provisions and procedures indicated in the call Erasmus for Study 2024/25 published on February 1, 2024, remain valid. However, new deadlines and time frames for application, selection, and the mobility period are defined here.

Additionally, the updated tables for financial contributions, revised and modified following the signing of the 2024 Erasmus+ financial agreement between the Erasmus National Agency/INDIRE and the University of Pavia, are provided.

Students who have already been assigned an Erasmus Studio mobility period for the academic year 2024/25 are not eligible to apply for this second call unless they have already withdrawn from that period.

The second call allows for the mobility period to be conducted solely in the second semester of the 2024/25 academic year (to be completed by September 30, 2025).

Under this call, mobility within Double Degree programs is not permitted.

FINANCIAL CONTRIBUTIONS

Monthly allowance based on the destination country – Item A

The Erasmus+ program divides participating countries into groups based on the cost of living in those countries, and provides differentiated grants according to the group to which the destination country belongs, as shown in **Table 1** below:

*** The University of Pavia, as specified by the Erasmus Regulations, cannot allocate more than 20% of the total budget available for mobilities to Partner Countries.**

The use of Erasmus funding is incompatible with other European Union funds. Therefore, Erasmus mobility grants cannot be combined with other European financing, including PNRR grants, PON funds, and other EU contributions (such as those often associated with certain doctoral scholarships).

Winners can still participate in the program by waiving the Erasmus grant.

Students enrolled in specialized schools and recipients of specialty scholarships may benefit from EU funding (subject to specific cases of incompatibility to be verified with the International Mobility Unit and the Health Specialization Schools Unit).

¹ For mobility to Switzerland, if funded directly by the Swiss government, they will not receive the contributions under Item A. In this case, the procedures and timing for the mobility grant will be defined by the foreign universities. If for the academic year 2024/25 the Swiss government does not fund the mobilities, the University of Pavia will provide a monthly allowance equivalent to the amount applicable to Group 1 countries

Monthly allowance based on personal economic situation (ISEE) and/or fewer opportunities – Items B and C

1 – Economic requirements based on ISEE from 0 to 50,000, according to **Table 2** (subject to possible changes based on any new ministerial or University provisions):

2 – Fewer opportunities: students who meet one or more of the following conditions:

- a. special needs (certified physical, mental, and health conditions)
- b. refugee and/or international protection status
- c. with minor children
- d. workers²
- e. professional athletes
- f. orphans of at least one parent
- g. children of victims of terrorism and organized crime

The expected economic contribution for these categories is **€250.00 per month (Item C)** and they are not cumulative.

2 Student actively engaged, not occasionally and not under the employment of a family member up to the 2nd degree inclusive, for not less than six months within the year, in any documentable activity of subordinate, autonomous, or professional work, in the public or private sector (definition as per University Regulations governing enrolment on a part-time basis)

Grant for sustainable travel – Item D

The University of Pavia provides travel grants:

- to those who undertake their mobility period in China (variable amount as indicated in Table 3 + per diem)
- to those who undertake their mobility period in one of the Programme Countries or in eligible countries of Regions 13 and 14 (limited to the per diem).

The amount can consist of:

1. a variable part based on travel distances, as shown in the following **Table 3**:

The International Mobility Unit will use the [distance calculator provided by the European Commission](#) to determine the distance between the place of origin, which will always be considered as Pavia, and the location of the activity⁴.

2. a per diem equivalent to the daily amount corresponding to the monthly grant (i.e., total monthly grant / 30 days = per diem amount). The per diem will be provided for each day of travel required to reach (or return from) the final destination, for a maximum of 6 days. Travel days must not be included in the period specified in the certificate of completion issued by the host University.

The contribution will be provided as a one-time payment and can be considered for a single way, either outbound (within a maximum period of 30 days from the declared start date of mobility as stated in the attendance certificate) or return (within a maximum period of 30 days from the declared end date of mobility as stated in the attendance certificate). Travels to and from Pavia during the mobility period will not be eligible.

3 Only trips where the majority of the route is travelled using low-impact transportation means will be considered sustainable

4 Regardless of the actual departure location, Pavia will always be considered as the point of origin. For example, if the destination is Madrid, the distance between Pavia and Madrid (1 172,38 km) will be calculated, and then the corresponding range will be applied (i.e., between 500 and 1 999 km)
